THE MOST BEAUTIFUL SHRINES OF UZBEKISTAN

There are many Holy places on the territory of Uzbekistan. Among them there are recognized cultural monuments and shrines that few people know about. We have collected for you unknown yet objects that differ in their beauty and history.



SULTAN UWAIS KARANI COMPLEX

There are several places in the Muslim world where Sultan Uvais Karani is buried. And one of these places is located in the Chartak district of Namangan region. Cemetery on this site was erected in the XII-XVI centuries and over the time there was a large architectural complex, including a mosque, mausoleum, library and Museum.





BIBI ONA MAUSOLEUM

Bibi Ona archaeological site is located in Chust and dates back to the late Bronze age. On its territory is the Holy spring "Bibi Ona-Kainar Bulok". Numerous finds were found near the source, confirming the ancient past of the monument. According to legend, Bibi was a Princess, and the water itself, named in her honor, has healing properties.





TOSHMASJID COMPLEX

In the village Vangazi in Kyzyltepa district in Navoi region built magnificent architectural complex Toshmasjid.

The ensemble was built in the XVI century and consists of a mosque, minaret, madrasah, bathhouse and an ancient cemetery. Art historians and historians suggest that this place was a major Sufi center of the XVI century.





AK-SARAY MAUSOLEUM

Memorial and religious building of the XV century is located in Samarkand. The building is the tomb of the Samarkand Timurids. Outwardly, Ak-Saray seems unattractive, but the interior is truly luxurious and unique. The interior walls, sails and dome are covered with ornamental paintings made in the "kundan" technique with abundant use of gold





SAID MOHI-ROYI-JAHON COMPLEX

The complex is located in Khiva near the ancient cemetery Sirachali Aryk. The memorial ensemble consists of three groups of monumental structures, including the tombs of some Khiva khans. According to legend, once there lived a Sufi Sheikh-Chadirli Ishan.
